**Next Steps:**

**July 13<sup>th</sup>** – The Vestry will appoint the Chairs of the Profile and Search Committees. The members of the Committees will be appointed at a later meeting.

**July 19<sup>th</sup>** – During Sunday Morning Prayer Mother Judith will commission these Chairs and they will be Readers in the service.

**July 20<sup>th</sup>–August 17<sup>th</sup>** – The Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT), also known as the Holy Cow Survey will be available to be completed online.

**August 10<sup>th</sup>** Canon Simpson will meet with the Vestry, Search and Profile Committees to introduce the logistics of the search and to do a Mutual Ministry Review.

**September 12<sup>th</sup>** Canon Simpson will meet with the Vestry, Search, and Profile Committees to review the

results of the CAT and to advise them on beginning work on the Profile.
