The diocese has developed checklists for preparing to re-open our buildings. The Vestry will develop a strategy based upon these checklists, including disinfecting the sanctuary and the church building. When we have protocols for meetings, small groups, and office operations, we will submit our plan to the Dean for review. When the Dean has approved the plan, it will be sent to the Bishop for review. With the Bishop's approval, we will implement our plan.

Until then, we will continue with online Sunday Morning Prayer. Music will be incorporated into the service, and we will explore new ways to continue building our community.
